



SCHOOL UNIFORM

A school's uniform plays an important role in promoting a positive image of the school and creating a sense of identity and belonging. It also supports safety, especially when out of the school. At Alberton Primary School parents, staff and children support the School's Uniform expectations.

The school expects every child to be in school uniform every day.

Enrolment at the school is on the understanding that Alberton Primary School's Uniform will be adhered to.

Alberton Primary School's Uniform is set by the School Governing Council as follows:

Navy blue shorts
Navy blue skort, netball skirt or knee length shorts
Navy blue check fabric dress
Navy blue polo shirt
Navy blue/black track pants or trousers
Navy blue/black jeans (with no markings/patches/rips)
Navy blue zip jacket, jumper, windcheater (with or without hood)
Navy blue long sleeve polo shirt
Navy blue 'bucket' school hat
Navy blue tights/leggings/stockings
Black Year 7 polo shirt
Black Year 7 zip jacket or jumper

HATS

It is school policy that **all** children are to wear navy blue 'bucket' **school** hats for all organised physical education activities and while playing outside at recess and lunchtime in Terms 1 & 4. **We have a 'no hat no play' policy during Terms 1 & 4.**

The school hat policy is fully supported by the Cancer Foundation as an effective means of protecting children from the harmful effects of over exposure to UV rays.

HAIR

Children must ensure that their hair does not create a health or safety risk. Children with hair shoulder length or longer are required to tie their hair back. Long hair must be tied back as a preventative measure in avoiding/containing the spread of head lice.

JEWELLERY

Children who have their ears pierced are required to wear only sleepers or studs whilst at school. Facial piercings are not encouraged and must be covered at school.

COSMETICS

The wearing of cosmetics is not permitted.

SPECIAL GROUPS

Cultural dress can be incorporated into Alberton Primary School's Dress Code by negotiation with the Principal.

FOOTWEAR

Children are required to wear sensible, closed-in footwear to school, or sandals with back straps.

NB: Attendance at events representing Alberton Primary School (eg: Interschool Sport) as well as eligibility for student leadership positions (eg: Children's Parliament, Choir) is dependent on students adhering to the above Dress Code.
