Vacation Care Booking Dates

Bookings **open on Monday 2nd September** for school aged children who attend Alberton Primary School. Bookings **close on Wednesday 11th September**. Any bookings received after this date may not be processed and waitlists may apply.

In line with the Department Regulations, pre-school bookings are subject to availability.

All bookings will be **confirmed by Friday 20th September** via e-mail. You can also check your app!

To Book In

Pick up an enrolment form for each child attending from OSHC or the school reception. Forms need to be returned to OSHC.

If you are eligible for CCS, you must register with Centrelink prior to enrolling in our program. Please ensure you go to MyGov and accept the service if new and when you do not use the program for 13 weeks or more.

Due to allergies, foods containing **nuts are NOT to be brought to OSHC.**

Recycled donations are happily welcomed e.g. ribbon, material, boxes, craft items.


What to bring:

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Bookings for vacation care will only be accepted when accounts are no more than 2 weeks in arrears or exceed \$200 at the time of booking. Bookings may be placed on a pending list if payments have not been made.
- To avoid any disappointment, please book your child early.
- Please note that we have clear regulations regarding ratios and if required, the DfE priority of access guidelines will be actioned.
- Cancellations must be made 5 working days in advance to avoid full charge.
- Children need to wear sun smart clothing that covers their shoulders and back. Shoes need to be toe enclosed footwear. For their own wellbeing, children may have restricted play if attire is not suitable.
- Late pick up Fee is \$15 for the first quarter hour then doubled each quarter after 6.01pm.
- Please notify the service by 9:00am if your child will not be attending for the day, as this will allow us to contact families on the waitlist.
- **Water World** - Please note Monday the 30th of October is a booking for school aged children 6 years of age and above only due to Water World Safety Guidelines. Children under the height of 100cm will not be able to access the slides as per Water World Safety Guidelines also. We are capped at 40 students on this day.

Code	Explanation
L.O.	<p>L.O. stands for learning outcome/s. Each of the programmed activities have learning outcomes which they relate to. These learning outcomes come from the National Quality Framework approved learning frameworks. These include the Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF), for children 5 years of age or younger, and My Time, Our Place Framework (MTOP), for school aged children. Extension or Ext	<p>Ext is short for extension. When the program says 'ext' or 'extension', it means that the program activity is an extension of a learning observation completed by educators for children. Next to extension is the child/ren's initials who were involved in the original learning observation, and the extension will therefore be applicable to them.</p>
Proposal Winner	<p>Proposal winner refers to children who have come up with an idea for vacation care and they have come up with a proposal and written it up and given it to Tanysha (SPO). Each child is offered the opportunity to put forward proposals each school holidays. Submitted proposals are then read and reviewed by OSHC staff and suitable proposals for the program are selected and programmed into the respective vacation care program.</p>
Family Suggestion/Favourite	<p>'Family suggestions' is employed in our vacation care programme to help our families' express ideas and improvements. To produce these suggestions, we invited families to take part in surveys that would aid in the development of our vacation care programs. Along with ongoing conversations about how to improve our programs in the future.</p>
